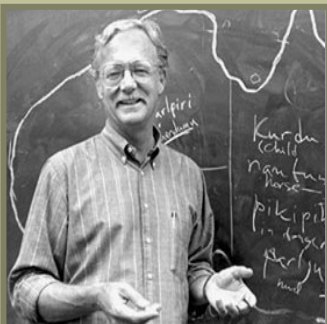
Kelly Washington
